

ST CHARLES TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING
March 11, 2026

1. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Cross at 7:00 p.m.
2. Supervisor Cross asked Anthony Farinella to lead the pledge of allegiance.
3. Clerk Mary Lynn Swanson took the roll:

Also present were Diane Hemmingsen, Assessor, Annette Miller, Bookkeeper, Brooks Ronzheimer, Cemetery Superintendent, Pat Griffin, Attorney and Dave Medlin, Deputy Assessor.

4. Supervisor Cross asked if there were any questions, or concerns regarding the minutes of February 11, 2026.

Hearing none, Supervisor Cross requested the approval of the above-mentioned minutes dated February 11, 2026.

John Hoscheit made a motion to approve the Minutes of February 11, 2026. Jim Flanigan seconded the motion. 4 ayes. 0 nays. Motion carried.

5. Supervisor Cross asked if there were any questions or concerns regarding the accounts payable and payroll audits of February 20, 2026, excluding any Town Board reimbursement expenses.

Hearing none, Supervisor Cross requested the approval of the above-mentioned payroll audits.

John Hoscheit made a motion to approve the Accounts Payable and Payroll Audits of February 20, 2026. Anthony Farinella seconded the motion. 4 ayes. 0 nays. Motion carried.

6. Supervisor Cross requested the approval of the current expenditures in the amount of \$19,956.88 for all Town, General Assistance and Highway funds and \$1,767.99 for the Cemetery funds, excluding any Town Board reimbursement expenses.

John Hoscheit made a motion to table the approval of the current expenses to April board meeting. Jim Flanigan seconded the motion. 4 ayes. 0 nays. Motion carried.

A. There were no reimbursement expenses for the Town Board.

7. Supervisor Cross asked if there were any questions regarding the Six Month Audit.

There were none.

Supervisor Cross requested a motion to approve the Six Month Audit.

John Hoscheit made a motion to approve the Six Month Audit as presented, seconded by Anthony Farinella. 4 ayes. 0 nays. Motion carried.

8. Supervisor Johnson requested the approval of the Agenda for the Annual Town Meeting on Tuesday, April 14, 2026 at 7:00 PM.

Jim Flanigan made a motion to approve the Agenda for the Annual Town Meeting, seconded by John Hoscheit. 4 ayes. 0 nays. Motion carried.

9. Kane County Sheriff's Office was not present.

10. Quarterly Cemetery Report.

Brooks stated the new mowers are in. He gave the board information regarding the new software system they are looking into. All records are digitized and will be switched over to the new system.

11. Supervisor Cross asked if there were any comments, questions or concerns from the audience.

Dan Nolan lives in the River Grange subdivision on Barton Dr. He made comments regarding the trash referendum stating he'd like to leave well enough alone. He also made comments regarding the paving that was completed last year. He is not happy with the quality of the paving.

Anthony Farinella explained the issue of the garbage referendum.

Jim Flanigan and John Hoscheit also gave additional information. Discussion ensued.

13. Supervisor Cross asked for any comments from the elected officials.

Terry Cross gave an update on the new website. We are going with Totally Townships. It cost \$500.00 to start and then \$175 per month for top level services.

John Hoscheit asked the guests why they attended the meeting.

Jim Gaffney then stated their concerns on Cedarhurst Senior Community.

John Hoscheit explained and talked about the Forest Preserve, roads, etc. The City did not talk to the township about the development.

John Hoscheit explained annexation.

Pat Griffin stated the City of St. Charles can jump over property owned by the Forest Preserve to annex it into the city.

Jim Flanigan asked Terry if this topic would be talked about at the intergovernmental meeting.
